







1 Bless the Lord, O my soul; And all that is within me, *bless* His holy name!



 - ▣ Proverbs 29:18 tells us that without vision, the people perish. One translator states that without vision, the people cast off restraint.



 - ▣ When we look to the past through the lens of vision, the past serves as a textbook and a reminder.




We remember his benefits because they not only remind us of what God has done yesterday, they also remind us of what God will still do today.

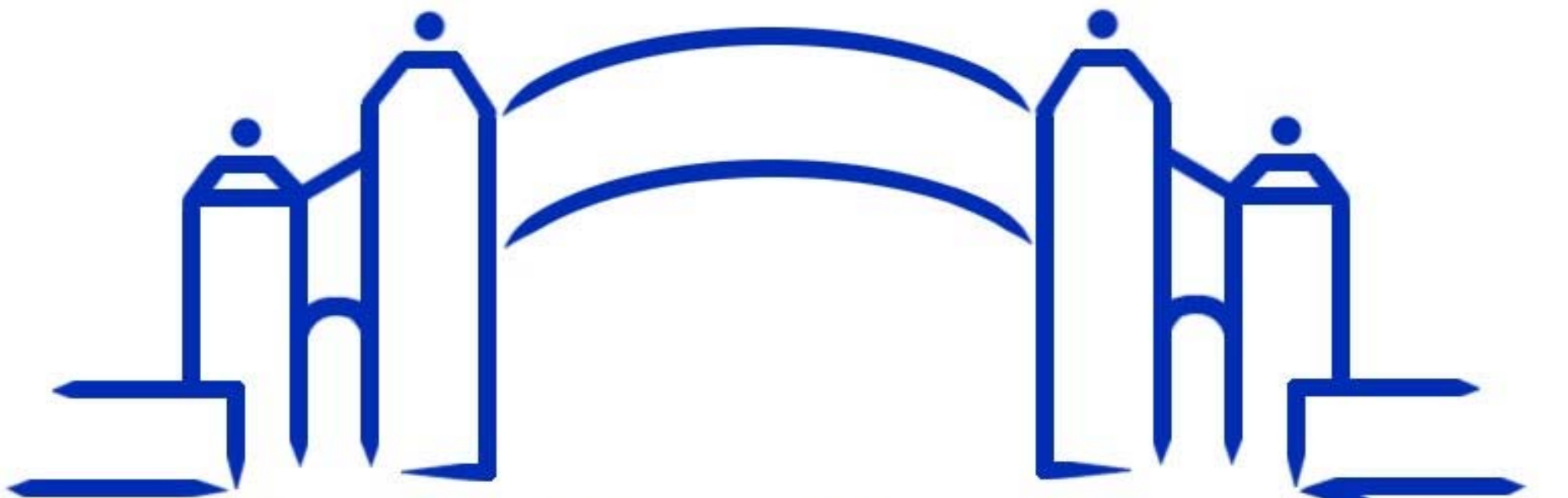
